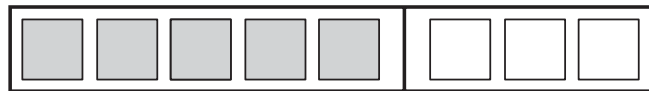

Then 3 more children join them.

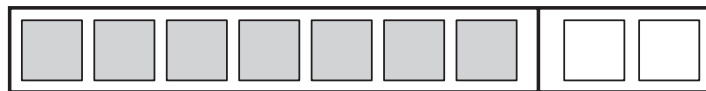
How many children are

Then 2 more children join them.

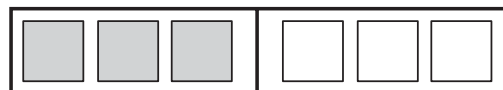
How many children
